When ISO 45001 ‘Occupational health and safety management systems – Requirements with guidance for use’ is finally released (around mid to late 2017) there will be a new standard for Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) which is expected to replace BS OHSAS 18001 and AS/NZS4801.
